## **III. Innovation: Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA) Program Application**

### **A. Description:**

The City of Roseville is in the process of a Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA) application as part of a program within the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA). The WIFIA Program provides low interest, low cost loans for water and wastewater infrastructure projects across the nation. This presentation will provide an overview of the US EPA's WIFIA Program for water or wastewater utilities considering federal funding opportunities, the water and recycled water projects the City of Roseville is looking to fund through this program, and some of the lessons learned along the way.
